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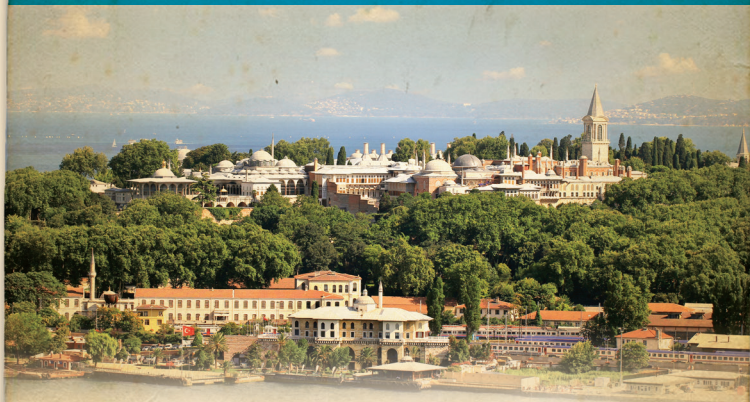

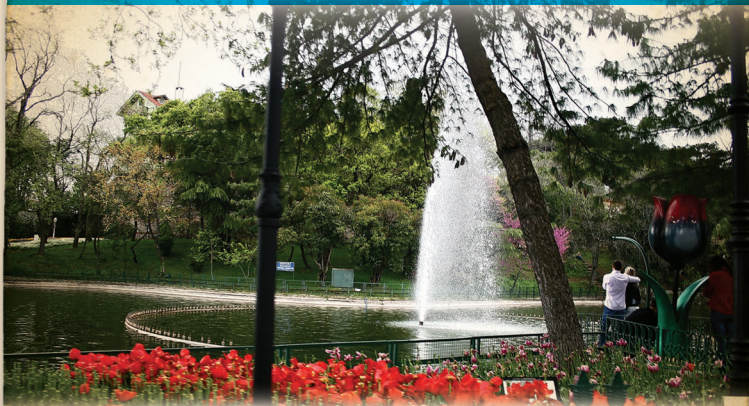

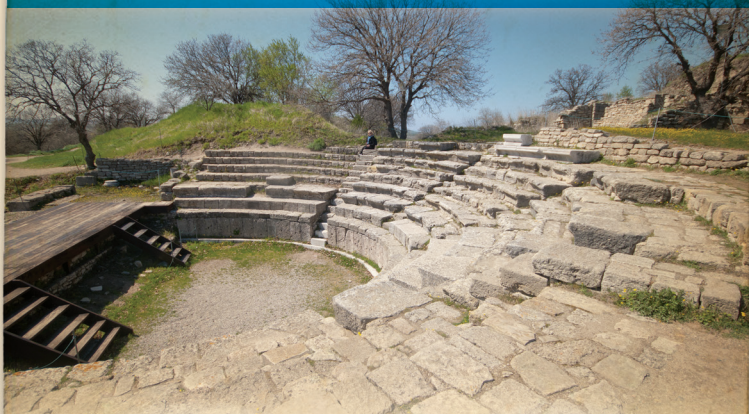

EPHESUS: The tour starting with Isa Bey Mosque, then drive to an Ancient City Ephesus which is located on the west coast of Asia Minor, stroll past the Celsus Library, the Temple Of Hadrian and the Trajan Fountain in the Ancient Ephesus. After walking on the historical marble street to the Great Theater where St. Paul preached will meet at the end. Open buffet lunch in a local Turkish restaurant. In the afternoon will visit the carpet cooperative weaving center to see how the Turkish carpets are made by hand. Proceed to House of Virgin Mary, it is believed where she spent recent years of her life. Finally proceeding to Temple Of Artemis (Diana), on the side of one of the seven wonders of ancient world. At the end fashion show will be at leather outlet center transfer back to... (L)

SARDES - IZMIR



ARCHAEOLOGICAL MUSEUM

Once capital of the ancient Lydia. The most important architectural works that were discovered here were The Synagogue and Gymnasium. The Synagogue was a section of a large bath-gymnasium complex, which was in use for about 450-500 years. In the beginning, middle of the 2nd century AD, the rooms the Synagogue is situated in were used as changing rooms or resting rooms. The complex was destroyed in 616 AD by the Sassanid Persians. Visit Temple Of Artemis situated 2 km south of the city. An altar had existed already here since the end of the fifth century B.C. to the before mentioned altar had its face to the west. Sardes had reaches its zenith. See the

famous Patroclus River once King Midas of the Phrygians had a bath in it. One of the Seven Churches of Asia Minor, the Sardes church is also heavily visited after lunch we proceed to Izmir, visit Kadifekale Castle. On the Mt. Pagos, the impressive ruins of the castle and its walls, we continue to Agora, or marketplace, was built during the time of Alexander the Great! We visit the Archaeological Museum. The Museum, which is close to Konak square, has marvelous collection of antiquities.

In Konak Square there is the Clock Tower, A beautiful marble tower that rests in the middle of the Konak district, standing 25 m (82 ft) in height. It was designed by the Levantine French architect Raymond Charles Pere in 1901 for the commemoration of the 25th anniversary of the ascension of Abdulhamid II to the Ottoman throne in 1876. Finally, we visit Kemeralti Market. Most visitors find the streets of Kemeralti Market area fascinating.

The people might have preferred to move and settle in mountains due to problems caused by the silting and the flooding of the river Meander.

HIGHLIGHTS OF ANTALYA



Demre is a town and its surrounding district in the Antalya Province on the Mediterranean coast of Turkey, named after the river Demre. Kekova, is a small Turkish island near Demre (Demre is the Lycian town of Myra) district of Antalya province which faces the villages of Kaleköy (ancient Simena) and Üçağız (ancient Teimioussa). Kekova has an area of 4.5 km² and is uninhabited. The historical Saint Nicholas is remembered and revered among Catholic and Orthodox Christians. He is also honored by various Anglican and Lutheran churches. Saint Nicholas of Myra is the original Santa Claus. The district was known as Kale until

it was renamed in 2005. A substantial Christian community of Greeks lived in Demre (Myra) until the 1920's when they were forced to migrate to Greece after the population exchange between Greece and Turkey. The abandoned Greek villages in the region are a striking reminder of this exodus. Abandoned Greek houses can still be seen at Demre and the regions of Kalkan, Kàs and Kaya which is a Greek ghost town. A small population of Turkish farmers moved into the region when the Greek Christians migrated to Greece. The region is popular with tourists today particularly Christian pilgrims who visit the tomb of Saint Nicholas.

DISCOVER NATURE OF ANTALYA



Karain Cave is a cave and a Paleolithic archaeological site located at Yağca village 27 km northwest of Antalya city in the Mediterranean region of Turkey. Karain is a prehistoric cave, situated at a height of about 370 m from the sea and about 80 m up the slope, where the Western Taurus calcareous zone borders on the travertine plain. Düden Waterfalls are a group of waterfalls in the province of Antalya, Turkey. The waterfalls, formed by the Düden River (one of the major

rivers in southern Anatolia), are located 12 kilometres (7.5 mi) north-east of Antalya. They end where the waters of the Lower Düden Falls drop off a rocky cliff directly into the Mediterranean Sea. Termessos was a Pisidian city built at an altitude of more than 1000 meters at the south-west side of the mountain Solymos (modern day Güllük Dağı) in the Taurus Mountains (modern day Antalya province, Turkey). It lies 30 kilometres to the north-west of Antalya. It was founded on a natural platform on top of Güllük Dağı, soaring to a height of 1.665 metres from among the surrounding travertine mountains of Antalya, which average only 200 metres above sea level. Termessos is one of the best preserved of the ancient cities of Turkey.

RED TOUR



Our first real encounter with Cappadocia almost Martian landscape is in the Derwent valley. We visit Pasabag's "fairy chimneys", where the voice of the wind harmonizes with songs of the fairies. From here we pause at Avanos center of terracotta art which is a popular destination because of its attractive old town with cobbled streets, and views over the river and is its production of earthenware pottery, it is also the most economic activity in the town. The ceramic trade in this district and its countless pottery factories date right back to the Hittites, and the ceramic clay from the red silt of the Kizilirmak has always been used. A visit to ceramic & tile center to see how the ceramics made by hand.

After lunch we visit the famous Goreme Open Air Museum to see the best examples of Byzantine art in Cappadocia. People of Goreme, at the heart of the Cappadocia Region, realized that these soft rocks could be easily carved out to form houses, churches, monasteries. These Christian sanctuaries contain many examples of Byzantine art from the post-iconoclastic period. These frescoes are a unique artistic achievement from this period. We complete the tour with a visit to the Uchisar Rock-Castle which has the numerous hollowed-out containers, rock tombs, and a large water cistern all welcome you as silent witnesses to history and human life giving you a panoramic view of the valleys of Cappadocia.

BLUE TOUR



The tour starts with Kaymakli Underground City which is one of the most interesting underground settlements in Cappadocia. The underground city was originally carved out as eight floors; however four floors are visitable. In war time about 5000 people can refuge in. Soganli Valley, an Open Air Museum in a wild natural setting near a typical Cappadocian village with its different style Rock-Cut churches and frescoes. Villages in the valleys, surrounded by the "table top" mountains, are spectacular. The valley was continuously inhabited since the earliest days of the Christian era, has churches that date from the 9th to 13th centuries.

Some of the churches contain inscriptions giving the exact dates of construction and thus have provided scholars with valuable clues to help date other churches in Cappadocia. Lunch and visit to Sahinefendi (Sobesos) - Sobessos, newly discovered (01 May 2002) mosaic houses & archaeological excavation site. Continue with Keslik Monastery near Cemil that hides its frescoes behind a very thin smoke layer which we can only see by torch light. Our tour finishes with a visit to Mustafapasha (Sinassos), an old Greek town with its spectacular old Greek houses; very fine examples of late Greek settlements and architecture.

CAPPADOCIA BALLOON TOUR



Cappadocia is the land with sensationonal sunrises with an unforgiving terrain. Kilometers of panoramic vistas and breathtaking nature can pass under you while suspended in open basket.

Balloon Tour offers a minimum one hour flight time in the air. You will be collected from your hotel early in the morning, usually before sunrise and driven to the take-off site. While you are having a light breakfast, you will watch the inflation of the balloon

then get a passenger briefing which explains basic rules & safety measures for the balloon flight. Then it's time to climb into the basket and highlight of your Turkey trip begins! The take off is gentle-soon you'll be taking hundreds of pictures over the valleys of Cappadocia. After the flight lands, there is a small celebration with champagne and you will receive your flight certificate. You will be driven back to your hotel around 08:30 am just in time for breakfast, going on a daily tour or a nap. Before you can decide whether you hate or love going to Turkish bath or Hamam, you need to experience it at least once, if it's your first visit to hamam, entering a Turkish bath in which you just relax and work up a sweat while your muscles loosen up.

Discover Cappadocia in a different way. You can ride off on horseback through the valleys and the fabulous landscapes of Cappadocia. Horseback riding allows you to cover a great distance on small tracks well away from the traffic and crowds. You can get a feel for the area riding through a full day exploring the fascinating frescoed and rock-carved churches of the Goreme open air museum, the fair chimneys of Pasabag and Devrent Valleys. Visit the unique Turkish village of Avanos, and after lunch participate in a half day horse riding tour. We continue to the Cappadocian town of Urgup and visit one of the well known wineries and sample some of the wine produced in the area. In the late afternoon enjoy a panoramic view over the Cappadocian lunar landscape before returning to your hotel.

GREEN TOUR



Start the tour with a spectacular view over Goreme from Esentepe. You will see the complete view of Goreme valley and Goreme village: fairy chimneys, rock formations and cave houses. Continue driving to Derinkuyu Underground City, one of the best preserved and deepest Underground Cities in Cappadocia. Derinkuyu is excavated to a depth of approximately 85 m. It contains all the usual rooms found in an underground city (stables, cellars, storage, rooms, refectories, churches, wineries etc.); a large room on the second floor was a missionary school with study rooms. Proceed to Ihlara Valley. This gorge is 16 km. long and both sides are lined with rock carved churches; there are more than a hundred little churches and houses. You will walk about 4 km along the river in the valley exploring the hidden churches.

At the end of your walk lunch will be served at Belisirma Village by the river. On the way back visit Selime Monastery, carved out of the rock by Christian monks in the 13th century. The size of the church makes a visit here astonishing. Stop briefly at Yaprakhisar panorama point for another view of this great Monastery (this is also the spot where famous movie Star Wars was shot.)

SPECIAL NOTES

Guests must be able to walk approximately 2.5 miles over uneven and cobblestone surfaces, inclines and 10-80 steps. Comfortable shoes, a hat and plenty of sunscreen are recommended as shade is limited the order of the tour itinerary may vary in order to avoid congestion. Guests should watch their step at all times in order to avoid injuries.

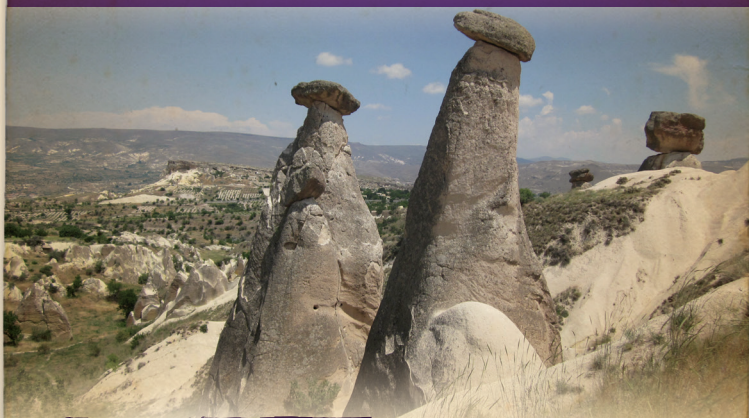
